

Local soldier killed serving in Iraq

According to sources, a team of U.S. Army officials visited the family business in Lovelady on Tuesday to announce the news that Army Spec. 4 Carl A. Eason had been killed in action.

Eason, 28, a 1996 graduate of Lovelady High School and the son of Martin and Susan Boedeker of Lovelady, was

killed in the line of duty while supporting Iraqi freedom in Iraq.
