

## COLONEL ERNEST L. WEBB JR.

Colonel Ernest L. Webb, Jr., age 93 of Enchanted Pines, formerly of Porter Springs, passed away Tuesday, November 13, 2007 in the East Texas Medical Center-Crockett. Colonel Webb was born July 23, 1914 in Itta Benna, Mississippi and had lived in Porter Springs for the past 38 years. Colonel Webb was a veteran of World War II, Korea, and Vietnam, and had retired after having served 28 years in the U. S. Air Force. Colonel Webb was a highly decorated officer having been awarded the Legion of Merit with two Oak Leaf Clusters and the Bronze Star. Colonel Webb was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Crockett.
