

STERLING L. EDWARDS

Mr. Sterling L. Edwards, age 81 of Crockett Texas passed away Monday, May 18, 2009. Mr. Edwards was born in Houston, Texas on February 5th 1928 to Alice and Kerpurnel Edwards in their home near what is now the corner of 34th Street and Ella Blvd. He worked on the Brandt Dairy near that home until he chose to enter the plumbing profession.

Mr. Sterling married Louise Daniels on May 1, 1948. Sterling was ordained a Deacon at Golf Drive Baptist in 1950 and together he and Louise faithfully served churches in Houston and then in Crockett. He continued in the plumbing profession and received his Master Plumbing license in

After a brief partnership, he started Sterling Plumbing Company in 1959 and together with Louise at his side, the business quickly grew. At one time, his wife, all three sons and his daughter worked for and with him. He retired in 1975 to Crockett, Texas where he was able to have his own cattle farm.
