And it further appearing to the court that the last will and testament of said Murphy and the record thereof were destroyed at the burning of said court house, and the court being satisfied that the copy here presented by this motion is a certified copy of said last will and testament. It is therefore ordered by the court that the motion be sustained, and said certified copy be recorded and stand in lieu of said original will, both in law and equity, and that said Admr Nail proceed to execute & carry out the same in accordance with law.
